## A NOTE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

There are SO many great things happening in Washington Township Schools! The district met all of its K-8 math goals and has the highest NWEA Math Proficiency since 2015. North Central student SAT scores increased an average of 17.6 points over the 2022 average and showed proficiency rates higher than the averages for Marion County (+15.2%), comparable large urban schools in Indiana (+17.2%), and the State of Indiana (+1.4%). Not to mention the 31 MSDWT teachers who were recognized with State and National awards!

This annual report highlights how YOU, as a donor to the WTSF, have supported this growth. From books in classrooms to adaptive bikes on playgrounds, you have enhanced educational opportunities across the District and contributed to the growth of not just students, but citizens.

I hope you feel an incredible sense of pride in what you have made possible. Our community is exponentially better because you are a part of it.

## COMMUNITY BOARDS

Washington township is a diverse community with a variety of needs. This year WTSF began a partnership with WTS social workers to develop community resource boards that help connect those looking for support with resources from their specific community. These boards offer faster and easier access to this important information.



### The Tower Garden

Learning about the environment and how our food is grown is important. The Tower Garden at Allisonville elementary helps students do just that by offering a space where they can work together to see how actions impact our environment.



### True North Library

Students attending True North Academy (a program offering an alternate path to graduation) were able to purchase a book of their choice which they will read, review, and then add to a library for future students to enjoy. Truly a gift that keeps on giving!



### Kids Dance Outreach (KDO)

Several WTS third grade classes got the chance to take part in Kids Dance Outreach, a fun and immersive music & movement experience. Programs like this are important because they support both the mental and physical well-being of students.





## Living History Day

Living History Day helps a new generation understand how the past has shaped our present lives. The experience connects current students to those in our community who served in an armed conflict or those who experienced how these conflicts changed life in the U.S. During the event, participants, including NC alumni, bring history to life for NCHS students and staff by sharing their stories, photos, and more to help ingrain in tomorrow's leaders the importance of learning from the past to inform the future.



## Indy Shakes

Indy Shakes is an Indianapolis based theatre troupe whose mission is to share the joy of live professional theatre with all. Thanks to grant funding, members of the NCHS english department were able to work with this group to create an equity-inspired partnership, bringing the racially diverse actors of Indy Shakes' into the intimate 9th grade classroom spaces of North Central to share their recent work titled Ricky III: A Hip Hop Shakespeare Richard III and educate students on the works of Shakespeare.

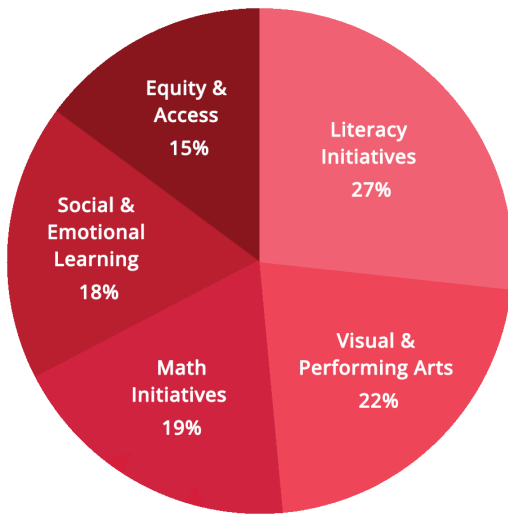




# HELPING EQUITABLE ACHIEVEMENT

## NEW ENDOWMENTS IN 2022-23

### THE LOTUS FUND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Supporting an annual scholarship awarded to an NCHS senior continuing their education in any capacity after graduation with a preference for a student from traditionally marginalized populations who, despite significant hardships, has shown a strong commitment to their education during their time at North Central.

### JOEL YONOVER ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Supporting two annual scholarships awarded to NCHS seniors who excelled in the performing arts, including speech and debate while maintaining a B average overall.

## HONORED SCHOOLS

Honored is a national nonprofit organization dedicated to honoring and elevating great teachers by celebrating the extraordinary impact they have on the lives of their students. Thanks to over 2,495 nominations sent in by students and families this year, WTSF had the pleasure of working with Honored (via their Honored Schools program) to award three WTS teachers with \$5,000 Honored Schools Life-Changing Teacher Awards. Funding for the awards was sponsored by the College Football Playoff Foundation.

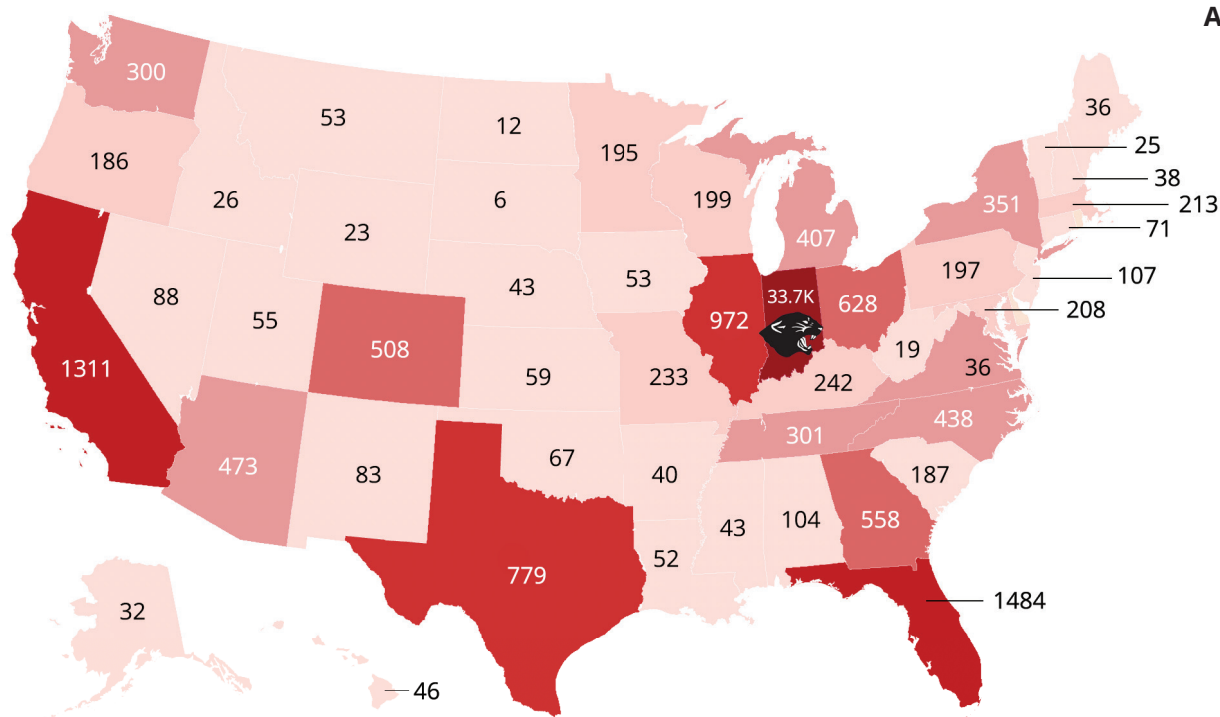

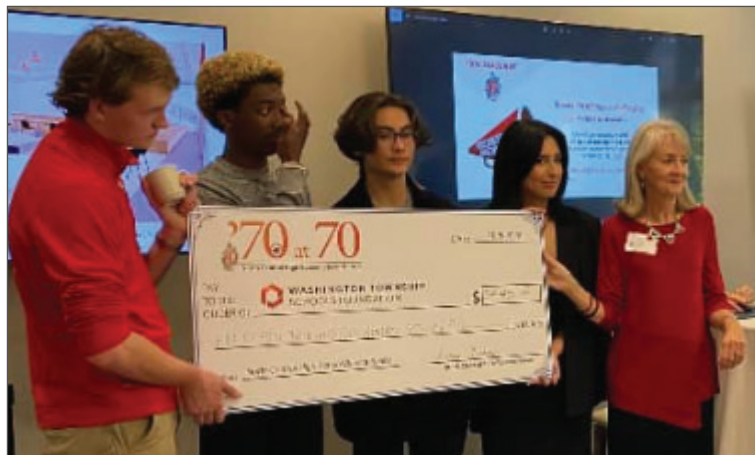
# PAST PANTHERS GIVE BACK

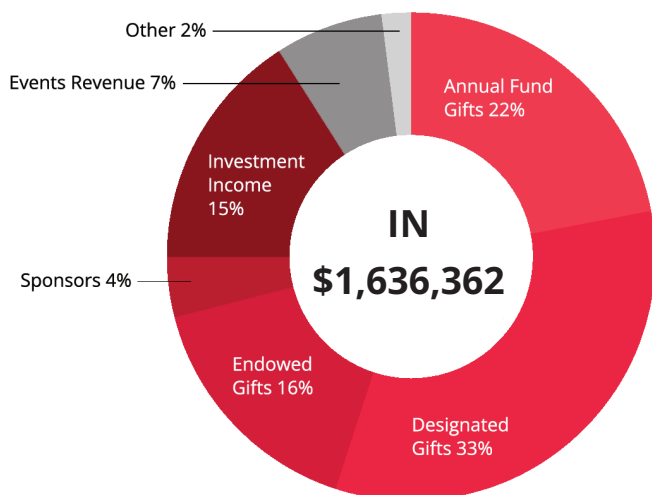

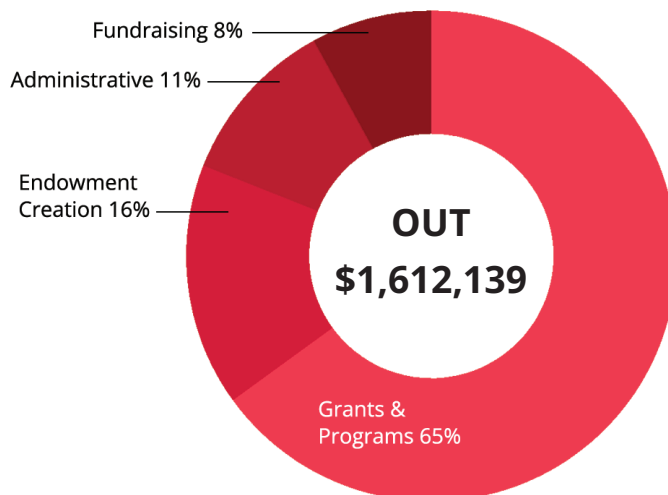


# FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT 2022-2023
